___ The Court hereby appoints _____, an approved private mediator of this Circuit to act as private mediator in this case. The parties or their attorneys shall, within two business days, mail or fax copies of the pleadings in dispute, case record sheets, financial affidavits, pre-mediation questionnaires and this order to the private mediator, together with notice of the status hearing.
