**JUDGMENT — SENTENCE TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS
SEX OFFENSES**

The Court FINDS THAT:

- 1. The Defendant, whose date of birth is _____ is adjudged guilty of the offenses set forth below.
- 2. The Defendant is entitled to "Good Time" credit as follows:
 - Time served on periodic imprisonment for the duration of its terms from _____ to _____ for a total of _____ days.
 - Time served on awaiting sentence on a bailable offense of _____ days; and a corresponding credit against \$ _____ fine of \$ _____ (\$5.day).
 - Other time actually served in custody of _____ days.
- 3. The Defendant is convicted of a Class _____ offense but sentenced as a class X offender pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-3(c)(8).
- 4. The conduct leading to conviction for the offenses enumerated in Counts _____ resulted in great bodily harm to the victim (730 ILCS 5/3-6-3(a)(2)(iii)).
- 5. The Defendant is convicted of First Degree Murder and no good time credit shall be applied (730 ILCS 5/3-6-3(a)(2)(1) or (2.2)).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, as follows:

A. That the Defendant be and hereby is sentenced to confinement in the Illinois Department of Corrections for the term of years and months specified for each offense:

C. That the Defendant is ordered to pay costs of prosecution herein. These fees, costs, and restitution (if applicable) are reduced to judgment against the defendant and are declared a lien upon the defendant's property.

D. That the Clerk of the Court deliver a copy of this order to the Sheriff.

E. That the Sheriff take the defendant into custody and deliver him to the Department of Corrections which shall confine said defendant until expiration of his sentence or until he is otherwise released by operation of law.

F. That the Defendant shall register as a sex offender pursuant to 730 ILCS 150/3. He shall read and sign all registration forms required by the Illinois State Police.

G. That pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-5-3(g), the defendant shall undergo medical testing to determine whether the defendant has any sexually transmissible disease, including a test for H.I.V. and A.I.D.S. The testing shall be performed only by appropriately licensed medical practitioners and may include an analysis of any bodily fluids as well as an examination of the

defendant's person. Except as otherwise provided by law, the results of such testing shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel and personally delivered in a sealed envelope to the judge of the court in which the conviction was entered for the judge's inspection *in camera*. The judge, acting in the best interests of the victim and the public, shall have discretion to determine to whom, if anyone, the results of the testing may be revealed. The cost of the testing shall be paid by the defendant and assessed as a cost of the proceeding to be paid out of bond posted.

H. That the defendant shall receive good conduct credits pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/3-6-3(a)(2)(ii)(85%).

I. This order is effective immediately / stayed until _____ at _____ AM/PM at which time the defendant shall report to the Sheriff's office to begin serving this sentence.

J. That the Illinois Department of Corrections shall collect specimens of blood, saliva or tissue and submit such sample(s) to the Illinois Department of State Police pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3. You shall pay to the clerk of the court an analysis fee of \$200.00 and any cost for obtaining the specimen.
