**ORDER FOR
HIV MEDICAL TESTING
AT PRELIMINARY HEARING**

Pursuant to 720 ILCS 5/12-18 (e), the Court finds:

- 1a. That at a Preliminary Hearing herein, the Court has found there is probable cause to believe the Defendant has committed a violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-13 or 720 ILCS 5/12-14 or 720 ILCS 5/12-14.1; **OR**
- 1b. That an Indictment has been returned herein, charging the Defendant with a violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-13 or 720 ILCS 5/12-14 or 720 ILCS 5/12-14.1.

2. That the victim herein has requested that the Defendant be tested for infection with human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, as follows:

A. The Defendant shall be tested for any sexually transmissible disease, including a test for infection with human immunodeficiency virus (HIV).

B. Said medical test shall be performed only by appropriate licensed medical practitioners, and shall consist of an enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (ELISA) test, or such other test as may be approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health; in the event of a positive result, the Western Blot Assay or a more reliable confirmatory test shall be administered.

C. The results of such test shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel involved in the testing.

D. The results of such test shall be personally delivered in a sealed envelope to the victim and to the judge who entered the order, for the judge's inspection, *in camera*.

E. The cost of such test shall be paid by the County and be taxed as costs against the Defendant, if convicted in these proceedings.
